Upon graduating from Washington High School in Blakely, Johnnie happily migrated to Newark, New Jersey in 1954. Several years later, she married the late Robert Lee Johnson in 1957 and their union was blessed with two children: Tyrone and Towanna.

Johnnie worked for Thermwell Products in Paterson, New Jersey for eight years. She was employed by Electron Technology of Kearny, New Jersey from 1962-1993. In 1993 she relocated to Pennsylvania and was employed by the Fredrick Company of Huntington Valley, Pennsylvania until 2001. In 2003 she returned to New Jersey, settled in East Orange, and retired.

Johnnie was a faithful and long-time member of The House of Prayer Episcopal Church in Newark, New Jersey. She reared her children with love and ran a tight ship with plenty of rules.
