Obituary

Enroy Augustus Ellis, “Danny” as he is affectionally known, the eldest of six siblings born to Egbert and Myrtle Ellis in Sandy Bay District, Hanover, Jamaica on January 13th, 1947. Danny attended the Sandy Bay All Age School, he excelled in English language and Mathematics and was able to gain a place at the well coveted Cobbla Camp (Institute of Training) in Manchester for boys.

After completing his training at Cobbla, Danny decided to remain in Manchester seeking employment. It was not long after that he got a job at a Fire station as a Trainee Fireman aged 21. He spent 12 years in the Fire service when home sickness took hold of him, he returned to his beloved Parish of Hanover. Danny worked at Mahoe Bay, Ironshore in the Tourist sector.

In 1982 he migrated to the United States of America and resided in the state of New Jersey. It was not too long before he found employment at Overlook Hospital in the engineering department working as a service engineer. Danny always wanted to be his own boss and it didn't take long for him to give up his job and became self-employed, managing his own landscaping business.

Danny was a very kind and generous person; he was always giving. He was easy going and one of those people who never complained and could always be counted on. He was a good listener and would offer advice when needed.

He met Gloria McKenzie in 1993 and they later became husband and wife.

Danny is survived by his wife Gloria Ellis, son Kevin Ellis, stepson Cassius Brown, Brothers Basil and Errol, sisters Norma and Eloise and granddaughters Sandra and Britney.

Danny will be sadly missed by all. We should all be thankful for knowing him and for his time on earth. I hope that everyone here remembers how wonderful a person he was and that his memory will continue to live on in our hearts and minds.

He will be remembered as a wonderful brother, a loving father, a great friend, a generous uncle, cousin, garden lover, farmer, a smiling face in town, or in the yard of his house by the side of the road. In all these ways and more, he made our lives richer and fuller. Now that he has passed away, of course there is emptiness and pain, confusion and maybe even anger at death coming to a man of only 74 years, but in many ways, the treasures of Danny's life are still here with us. He lives on in our memories and stories, and in what all of us have become because of him.

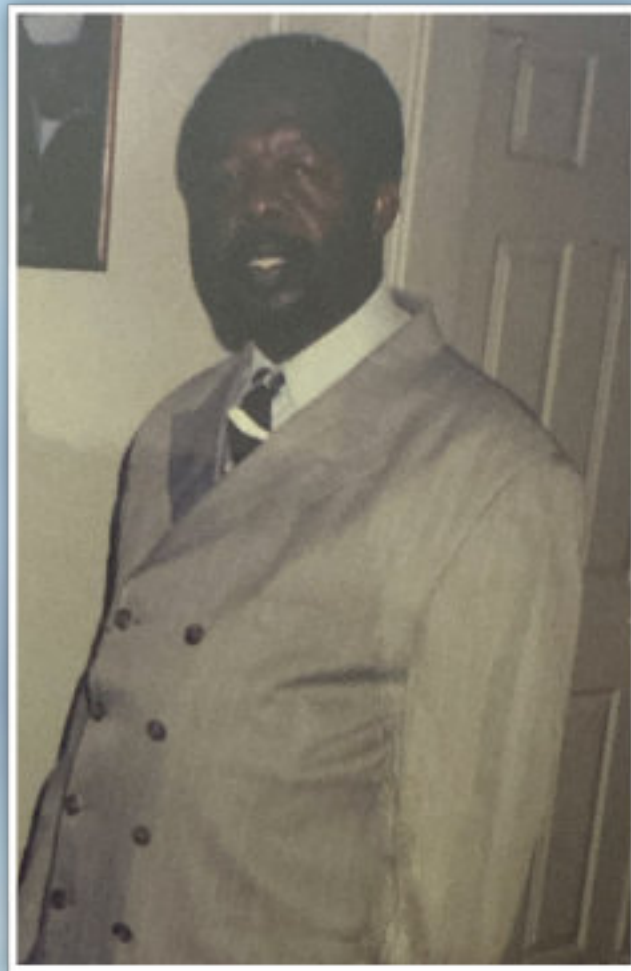
