His first jobs after leaving the university included that of a chemist at the Jamaica Flour Mills and a teacher at Holmwood Technical High School.

Horace immigrated to New York in the early 1970's, eventually working for the Department of Health. He attained a Masters' degree.

After retirement Horace enjoyed his years at CoOp City being social with his neighbours and keeping up with family members near and far.
