

Obituary

Benjamin F. Jones, Jr. was born January 23, 1939 to Benjamin F. Jones, and Marjorie Simpson.

He served in the Navy for 14 years as a radioman, which included being a broadcast supervisor in the communication division at the New York Naval Shipyard. He received Sailor of the Year from the 3rd Naval District. During his tours of duty he served on the USS Rogers, in San Diego, Norfolk, Va, as well as in Vietnam.
