He went on to earn a degree in Interior and Fashion Design at the Fashion Institute of Technology in New York City. Completion of his degree propelled him into a career that took him to many places across the world. Paul's immense talent led him to decorating the White House for Christmas in 1997 and 1998 for former President Bill Clinton, as well as the house of former Vice President Al Gore and his Wife Tippa four years in a row for the Spring, Halloween and Christmas seasons. Paul's interior design expertise also spearheaded him a guest spot on the Oprah Winfrey Show along with a guest spot on the Today Show. In addition to these accomplishments, Paul also did decorating jobs for celebrities including Whoopi Goldberg and Robert De Niro, to name a few. Over the last few years, Paul worked for the interior design company Creative Designs Limited, based in Hong Kong.

Paul transitioned from this earthly life on August 19th.
