On how I meant to be with you and you're meant to be with me

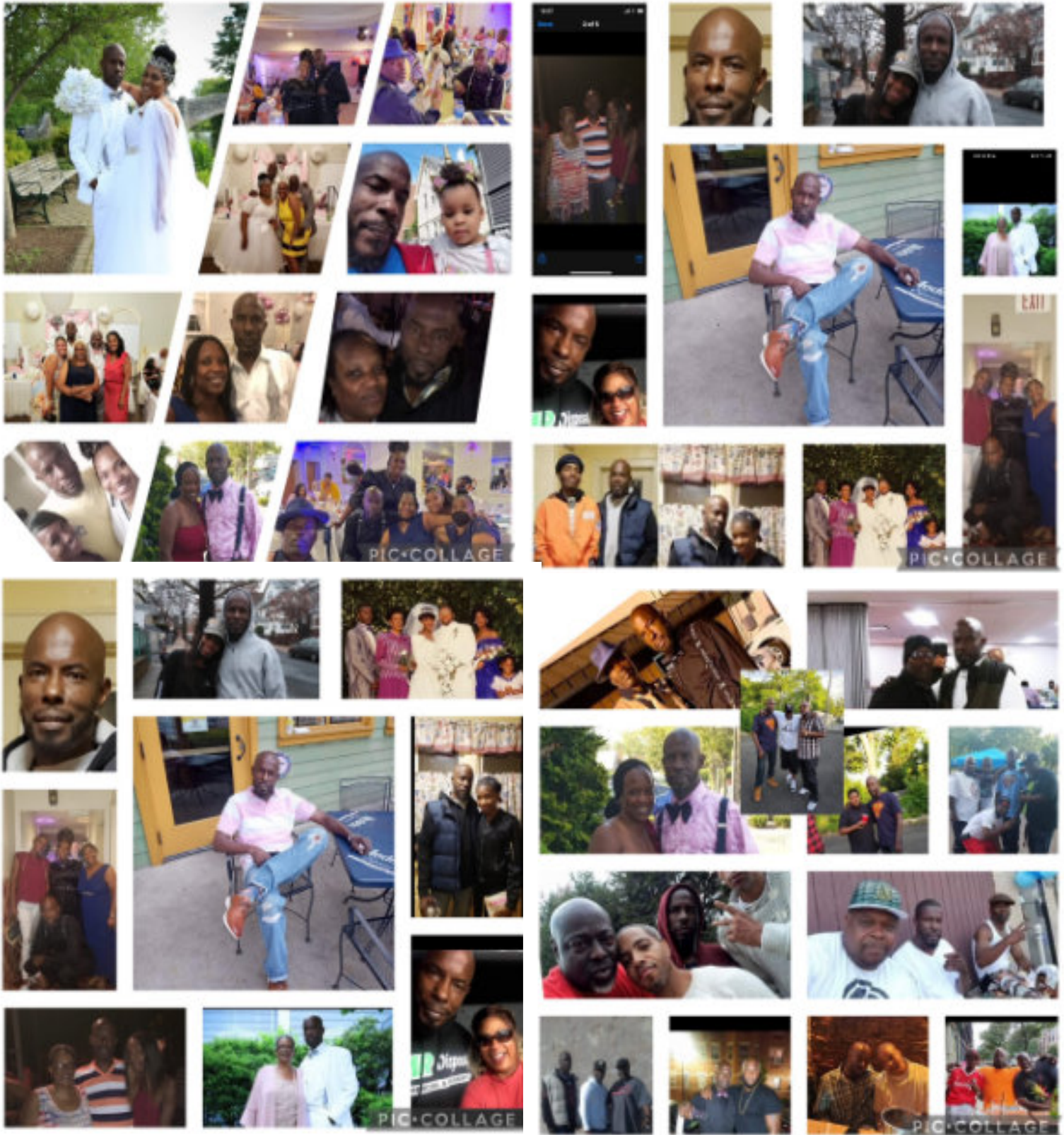
They say love is blind

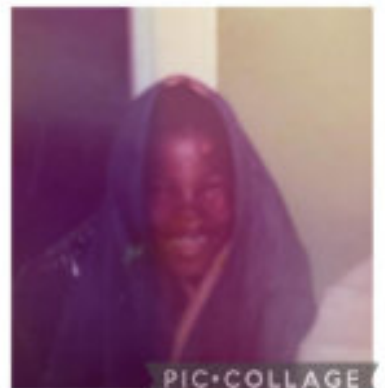
