Obituary

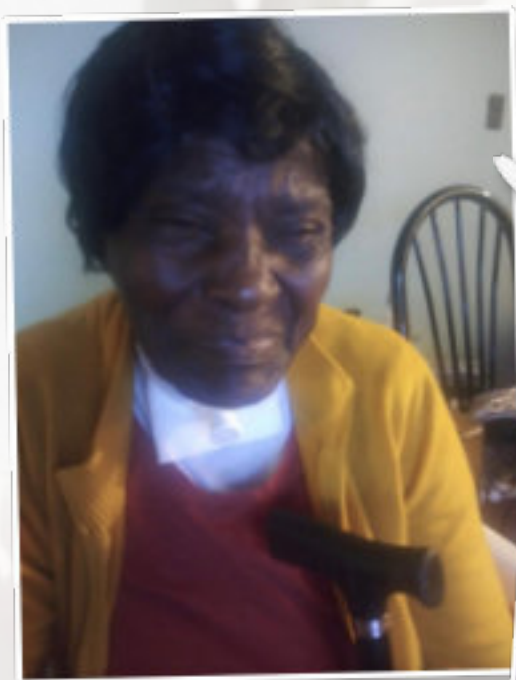

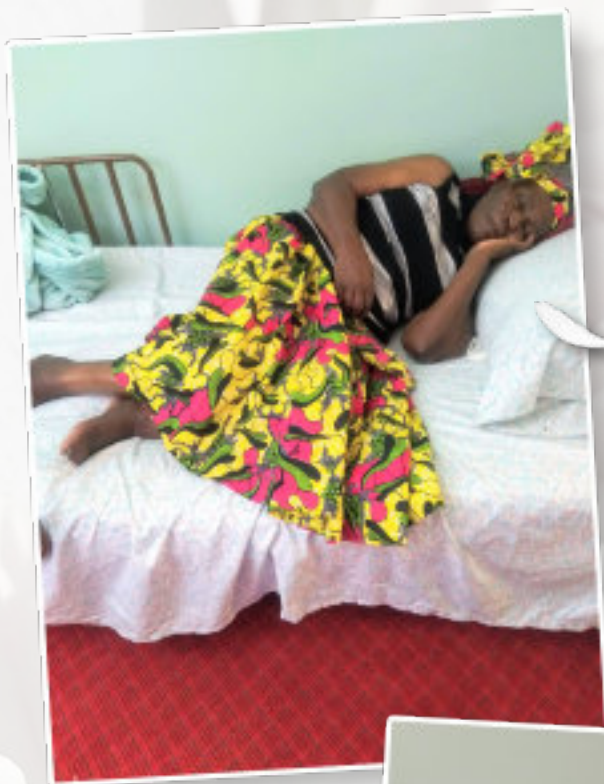
