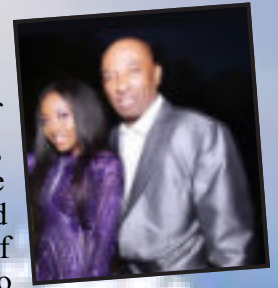

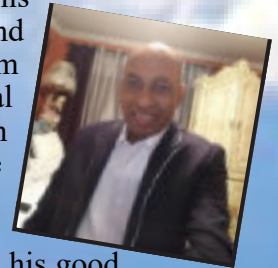
Obituary

Errol George Russell was born on April 18th 1957, in May Pen, Clarendon, Jamaica. He was the seventh of eight children, and the first son born to Francella Elizabeth and Edward Russell. As a child, family and friends noticed his genuine love for good conversation and, his passion for history and soccer. Errol often shared his enthusiasm for history, soccer and engaging conversation over a bowl of his tasty ital stew which was a specialty of his. Errol's gift of conversation made him a person many people in the community felt a connection with, particularly young people who respected and appreciated the advice he gave them. As a coach of the local soccer youth club, he was able to mentor and encourage young people to become more knowledgeable and conscious of the social issues in Jamaica and to do their part to contribute positively to society.



Errol was a gifted mechanic who could repair just about anything. After studying mechanical engineering at May Pen Secondary School, he worked for the May Pen Ice Company where he was able to hone his mechanical skills further. When he migrated to the United States, these skills would prove to be a great blessing and helped open doors of employment at several companies including JP Morgan Chase, GlaxoSmithKline and Days Inn. His mechanical expertise ranged from working to repair vehicles, commercial machinery and gym equipment. Errol was a dedicated and hardworking employee who always went above and beyond the call of duty.

Everyone who knew Errol, knew how much he loved his family. He was so proud of his children Leighton, Shantraill and Shania. Errol always found time to be a doting father and family man. Errol would faithfully drive his wife Rita and youngest daughter Shania from Brooklyn to Queens to ensure they were able to attend service at Oneness Pentecostal Tabernacle. On December 30th 2006, Errol was filled with the Holy Ghost and Baptized in Jesus' name. Errol had a heart for service and ministry. He was always willing to aid in the preparation and transportation of food for the weekly visitor's reception, or help when the church had special occasions. Even when Errol was diagnosed with cancer, he continued to serve and support in any way he could. During his battle with cancer, Errol maintained his good humor, positive attitude and sharp wit. He fought the good fight and held on to faith until the Lord called him home on October 4th, 2021. Errol's last words were "Abba," as he called to his heavenly father with his wife Rita by his side.

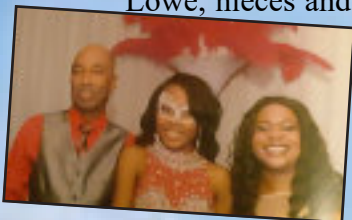

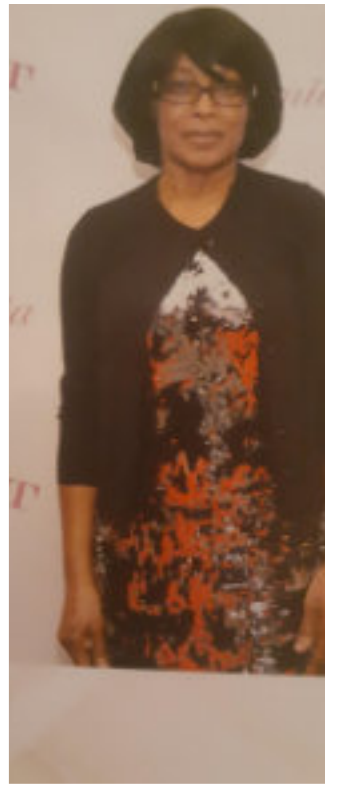

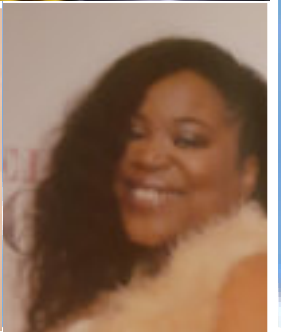
