

Reflection of Life

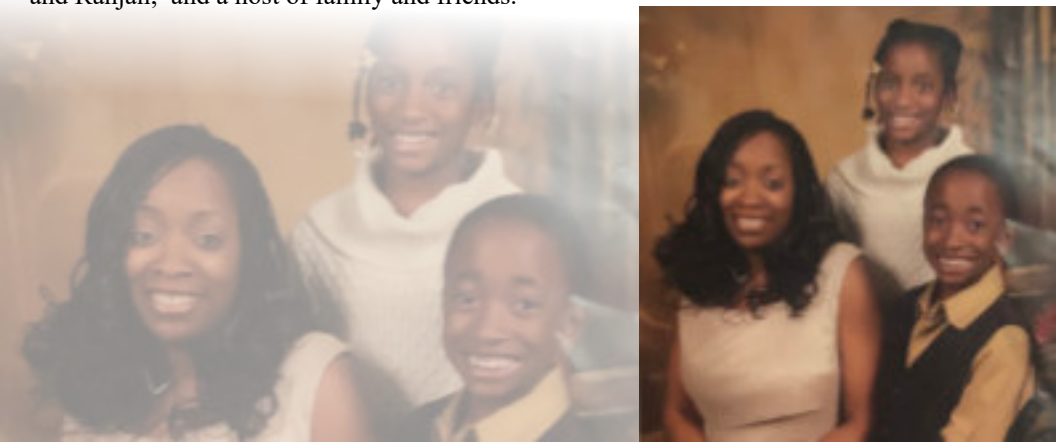
