Obituary

Surrounded by his family, on October 14, 2021, **Wade Toussaint Carter** peacefully slipped into eternity to be present with the Lord. Wade Toussaint Carter, better known as Toussaint or “Tutty” was born on March 13, 1958 in The Bronx, NY to the late Major Wade and the late Tinnie Carter. Toussaint grew up in the South Bronx, in Hunts Point, where he graduated from Stevenson High School in 1975 and went on to attend classes at Baruch College.
