Thomas used to attend Helen Keller Day program where he was engaged in numerous activities and enjoyed going out into the community visiting Flea market and the casino. Although, Thomas was hearing impaired, vision impaired and non-verbal he still shows signs of enjoying activities went out in the community.

If Thomas acted out it was evidence that he was not feeling well or he does not want to be bothered. In all his years, Thomas hardly aged a bit so instead of looking like the father figure in the residence. He was more like a son to staff and an elderly brother to the individuals. He was loved by everyone with whom he came in contact with. On October 5th, 2021 at the age of 62 he was called home. Preceding him in death are his brother and sister. Thomas is survived by his loving mother Gloria Christy, sister Francis, brother Dennis his massage therapist Carlene, his four roommates, all the staff of 540 Ocean Parkway and his Constructive Partnership family his Helen Keller family, his Care Manager Carlene Charles, and his CAB representative Michael Staton. Thomas will be greatly missed.
