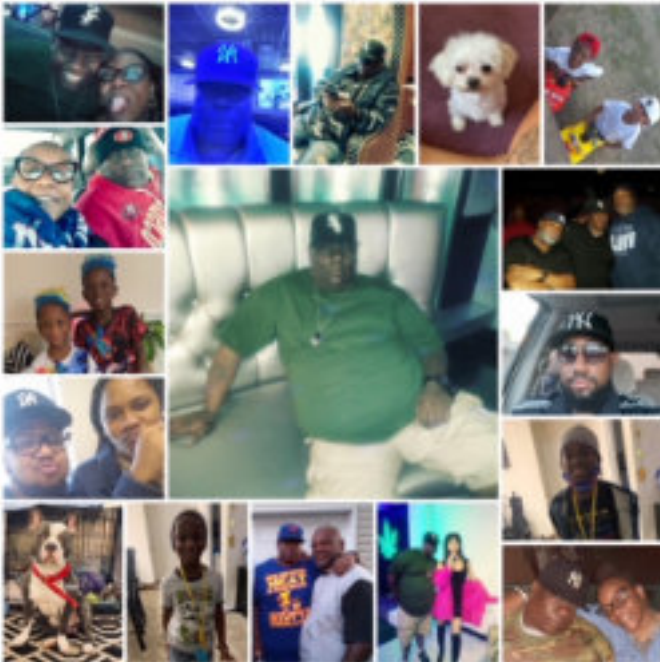
# Obituary
