In times of stress and strife.

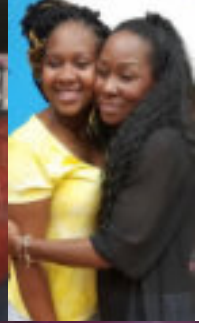
A true friend we could turn to
