# OBITUARY

On June 17, 1982, **Andre Anthony Nicholas Young** was born to his parents Newton Young and Marjorie Bromfield-Young at the University of West Indies Hospital - Mona Campus in Jamaica.

At a very young age, Andre immigrated to the United States to live with his family in the Bronx, New York. Andre quickly adapted to his new environment and made New York his home. He weaved New York lingo into his dialect using phrases like “no doubt, no doubt” or “good looking out” when conversing with others. He attended schools and built relationships with all people while residing in The Bronx, Queens and Mount Vernon, New York. He also developed a great love for supporting New York professional sports teams like the Knicks, the Giants, and the Yankees.

However, Andre was not the typical “New York City Kid” and he stayed very true to his Jamaican roots and ancestry. Andre enjoyed fishing trips and also cleaning the fish himself afterwards – skills he no doubt learned from watching three generations of women in his family prepare meals and bake pastries. Andre also learned that he had a passion for cooking delicious Jamaican cuisine and baking as well. He was an innovator in the kitchen experimenting with new flavors and recipe combinations to elevate the taste and presentation of his cultural foods. Every Easter season, Andre would utilize his baking talents and entrepreneurial skills with his start-up business “Mr. Young’s Easter Buns” to prepare and ship easter bun orders.

Andre was also an amateur photographer – capturing beautiful moments and lasting memories of his family and friends. Andre enjoyed being surrounded by all of his younger cousins, all of his aunts and uncles, and his best friend Ariel.

Andre possessed the types of qualities that the people around him were blessed to experience. By all accounts he was the type of person that “kept it real” as he would unapologetically let you know when a situation was wrong, and that you could do better. His loved ones describe him as always being available for support, good counsel, and advice, and compassionate in times of need. Andre could be stern, but he was also funny, and encouraged the people around him to pursue their dreams while also keeping them grounded in reality.

Andre was truly a one-of-a-kind son, brother, friend, and confidante. He will be deeply missed by his mother Marjorie Bromfield-Young, his father Newtown Young, his grandfather Alred Young, his grandmother Maxine Bromfield, his siblings, aunts, uncles, cousins, and friends.
