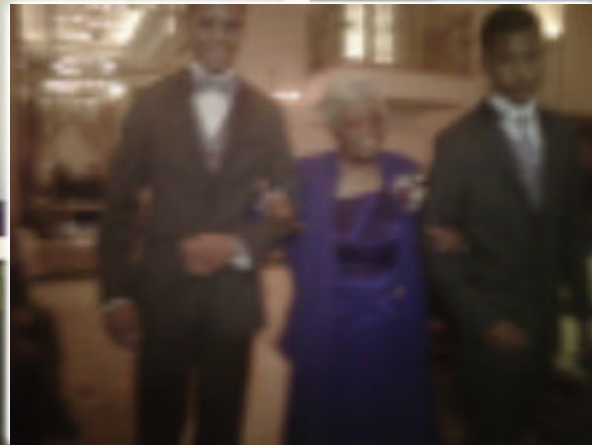

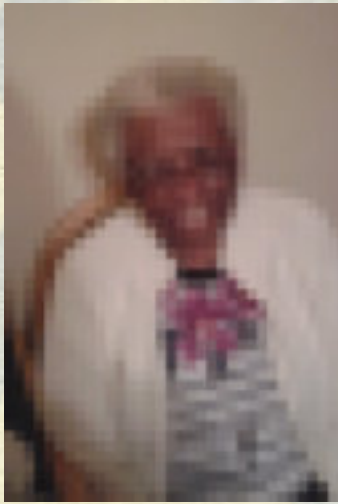
A Special Tribute To My Grandmother
