Aneki was well groomed by his parents. He always showed respect to any and everyone it did not matter the circumstances; he always remained humble. He was easily satisfied and never asked for much. He was taught to earn his own and never to depend on handouts, so he was always willing to work for what he wanted.

Aneki was a free spirited person. He was a dreamer. He could enter a room and brighten it with his smile. He made friends easily and was true to each and every one of them. He supported them, guided them, and made them happy.

Aneki your parents, family and friends stand here today with a broken heart. The loss of you is something for which we could never have been prepared for. We refused to prepare ourselves. We were not ready. You had so many plans for your future. You would have made those dreams come true.

Aneki came in this world as an angel and left us as an angel and a hero. He was born on October 27, 2003, and was shot on the November 17, 2021, and he saved seven (7) lives on the November 27, 2021.
