Obituary

His mother and father had been in love since virginity at ages 16 and 14 and gave birth to him at ages 18 and 20. Their union broke after 20 years and he was left to take on extra responsibilities to help support his younger siblings. The stress of this as a teenager gave him mental blocks that became stagnating to his growth.

Born on the cusp, he was A Cancer/Leo. His upbringing was very family oriented. Raised in the Bronx, New York mostly under his grandparents and mother's supervision he played with his uncles' children. Bishme and Brynnia by daughter of Grand Master Flash a Hip Hop icon. He was fascinated by the history stories of people who made it especially if they were related.

DeAndre broke generational curses for his intermediate family being the first to graduate high school, instead of just obtaining a GED like his mom and dad. When he was only 2 years old he toured with his dad who was then a signed music talent. Also, he trained Kung-Fu with his father and under renowned Shaolin Temple Abbott Sifu Shi Yan Ming. Where he made high vibrational friendships with Fulano Librizzi and Emanuel. He loved video games and playing basketball. He played for his schools JV team at Buckley where he graduated in 2020.

A month later he was working as a warehouse package handler for UPS. He began recording music and he has a few unreleased albums that are set to still come out 2022. He worked up until November of 2022 for the Hester Street fare on the production set up and break down.

DeAndre believed in God and prayed wholeheartedly for the reconstruction of his broken home. A home becomes dysfunctional without a adult male to lead by example in the household. He began looking for love in all the wrong places. He fell in love with Alicia Underwood his first and only true love. He was in love with being in love, and very head strong on family values and wanted to start his own family with her.

He began following in his father's foot steps of making music and representing the Culture of Hip Hop since it was second nature to him being born in the Bronx, New York the mecca of Hip Hop Culture. His best friend and rap partner aka YNT Yuan was murdered and this took him by surprise. DeAndre went into a deep depression. He had lost so much so soon without time to recover mentally. Him and his love of his life began arguing and fighting alot and he felt he was losing her too.

A life without love became too much to bare. He snapped when rumors were spread of his girlfriend cheating. They were going on 3 years together, they loved playing Uno together and Connect 4 was their favorite. They loved going to eat at restaurants and just being with each other all day long. They helped raise his younger siblings and loved playing match card games and watching cartoon movies for fun. They loved fast food and the idea of being together forever. They loved they loved they loved!

But unfortunately all good things come to an end. Who would of knew that DeAndre and Alicia were so in love that they would love each other to death.
