

Obituary

Adrienne was an avid reader and excelled in school. She developed her artistic side from a young age, playing the viola in junior high school, taking drawing classes, and as an adult, crocheting intricate works of art. An animal lover at heart, Adrienne volunteered for many years at a cat shelter, from which she adopted her cat Rosie. She enjoyed traveling and her favorite destinations included Aruba, Mallorca, and Ireland.

Adrienne obtained an Associates degree in Nursing from Becker College in Worcester, MA and often fondly recalled her time on campus. She later obtained a second Associate's degree in Nursing from Pace University and recently decided to further enhance her healthcare expertise by pursuing a Bachelor's degree in Public Health at Capella University, where she planned to take her penultimate class in January.

Throughout her life, Adrienne displayed a strong ability in working with some of the most vulnerable populations in New York. As a teenager, she served as a counselor and mentor to troubled kids at the YMCA. She began her extensive career as a nurse working in a drug and alcohol substance abuse center. In that role, she supported many people, including a relative through detox and their journey away from chemical dependency. This experience prepared her to join New York-Presbyterian Hospital Queens (formerly Booth Memorial Hospital), where she worked for more than 20 years in various departments, first as a nurse and then as a Nurse Manager. She worked for Anthem Blue Cross for the past 9 years.

Adrienne Susan Forbes passed away at the age of 65 on December 15, 2021 after a brief illness. Adrienne was predeceased by her parents, Alfred and Edythe, and her sister, Linda. She is survived by her brother Alfred, son Dylan, niece Hillary, many beloved first and second cousins, and countless friends.
