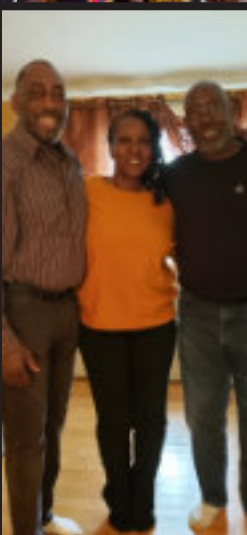

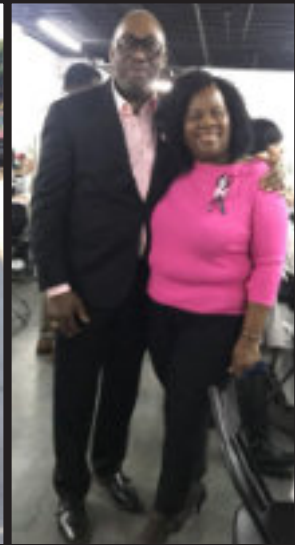












# *A Great Man*
