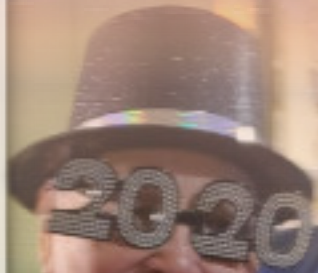

cumbered with a load of care?

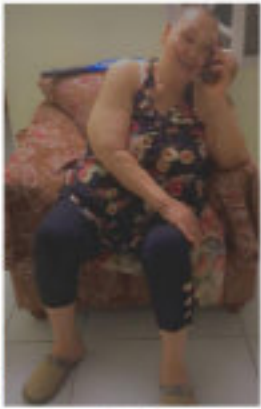
Precious Savior, still our refuge--
