Obituary

Nanotte ‘Magre’ Chery was born on August 12th, 1945 in Marchand-Dessalines, Haiti to Josephine Filia Chery and Milord Chery. While growing up in Haiti, she was raised by her aunt, the late Louisine Chery Adisson. Her aunt became her primary caretaker, and put her through school. When Nanotte entered adulthood, she married and later divorced Lexcione Elysee, and they had one son together named Carlo Elysee.

Magre loved Carlo very dearly, and wanted to give him a better life. Therefore, she decided to enter Les Affaires in order to financially support herself and her son. In the meantime, her aunt Louisine, became the sponsor to support her career as a merchant. Magre left her family in Haiti, and traveled to various countries like the Dominican Republic, St. Maarten, Venezuela, and Canada to buy and sell goods. It was while she was in Canada when she finally decided to move to New Jersey to join her family from Haiti for good.

Magre was a very caring, loving, and helpful individual. Her family meant the world to her, and to express her love and appreciation for them, she became their caregiver. Magre was always ready to cook, clean, or watch after anyone’s children. She became like a second grandmother to all her cousins when Grandmere passed away in 2007. Unfortunately, Magre became ill when her son Carlo passed away in May 2018. After fighting a four year battle, and surviving COVID-19, Magre was called home on January 21st, 2022.

Magre will always be remembered for her delicious food, infectious laugh, and her stories about living in Haiti. Magre leaves behind 3 grandchildren: Ronald Elysee, Billy Elysee, and Filliette Elysee. Her daughter-in-law, Marie Litane Odolph. Her nephew, Barthelemy Francois. 
