# Obituary

**Jenneth Robinson** was born to Thomas Palmer and Dorritt Brown in St. Ann, Jamaica on January 28, 1957. Raised by her father and grandmother, she grew up immersed in the Christian community that would be her lifelong support from an early age. Her involvement in church ignited her passion for singing and acting, evidenced by her ability to serenade anyone at any time, and any place.

Jenneth was blessed with three children, whom she enjoyed raising and caring for. She had a genuine nurturing spirit that would guide her decision to pursue a career in healthcare after immigrating to the Bronx, New York in 1993. As a Certified Nurses Assistant, she cared for the sick and elderly, until her retirement.

While she wore many hats throughout her life, the one that she enjoyed the most was the role of grandmother. Her grandchildren meant the world to her, and there was no good thing that she withheld from them, including the gift of song, which she used to teach them their ABC's and old Jamaican nursery rhymes. Her loving and caring demeanor inspired those in her local church to refer to her as Mother Robinson. In her love and care for those that were less fortunate, disadvantaged, orphaned, and weary, Jenneth lived a purpose-filled life, one that embodied the essence of her name, meaning 'God is gracious'

Jenneth is survived by her mother, Dorritt Brown, her twin son and daughter, Sean and Shauna Robinson, her youngest daughter, Sherrika Newsome and son-in-law Cameron Newsome, grandsons, Jayden and Josiah Sonson, Savion Robinson, Machai and Cairo Newsome, two unborn grandchildren, 5 sisters, and 6 brothers. She is preceded in death by her father, grandmother, sister Jenny, and brother Christopher.
