# Obituary

Today we are here to celebrate the life of **Dwight Alfredo Watson**, my brother, our brother, a father, an uncle, a cousin, a husband, a grandfather, and a friend. I'm (the person reading it name). This is true, a very sad day for all of us. We have lost a family member who was so dear to us.

Dwight Alfredo Watson is affectionately called Dave and Bittera. Born May 4, 1971 and left us on January 7, 2022. He was the ninth child of Mrs. Amy and Ronald Watson together, the eleventh child for Mrs. Amy Watson, and the fourteenth child for Mr. Ronald Watson. Dwight Watson was born in Kingston Jamaica at the Victoria Jubilee Hospital.

He was educated at Lila Thompson Basic School, Norman Garden All-Age School, and Vauxhall Secondary School. During those early years of growing up, we were very close as brothers, we lived for each other, we felt for each other, and we also looked out for each other. Those days were fun-loving, we had the same friends, we cooked, ate, and played together whether we are playing football, cricket, or even flying kites. I remember one day we were picking Ackee, Dave was the one who climbed the tree; while he was in the tree picking ackee the limb suddenly gave way, where he fell from about fifteen feet and hit his head. He got up, but he was staggering, and I was so frightened that I grabbed a bucket of water and threw it on him and rushed him to the nearby clinic where he was attended to. Dave was a very hard-working meticulous person at times, he loved to cook and whatever he did was well done.

From a young age, Dave began to create his own path while keeping the bond with his family. He started working and dating, where he had met a young miss by the name of Kedisha Marsha Montague (Antoinette). That union produced his first son, Davion Dwight Watson during those time he was also seeing another young miss by the name of Jessica Thyme (Toya), that union produced Sancarlos Jevani Watson his second son, they both grew close to each other even though things were not the way he wanted it to be.

Dave was very ambitious and wanted the best for himself and his family which he worked very hard to maintain. He worked with several companies, including the Caribbean Cement Company as a laborer before he departed to the United States of America in 2003.

At first, things were not what he wanted them to be but by perseverance, things took a turn, still not what he had wanted it to be, but he made a difference. While in New York he met Catherine to whom he married in 2005. With that union, he was able to file for his sons to be reunited with him.

Dave was always jovial, there was never a dull moment when he was around, his nieces and nephews adores him because of his fun-loving nature. Death oh death why have you treated us so? How can we lose you at your prime age of 50?!

and hear the brook and feel the gentle breeze; [Refrain]

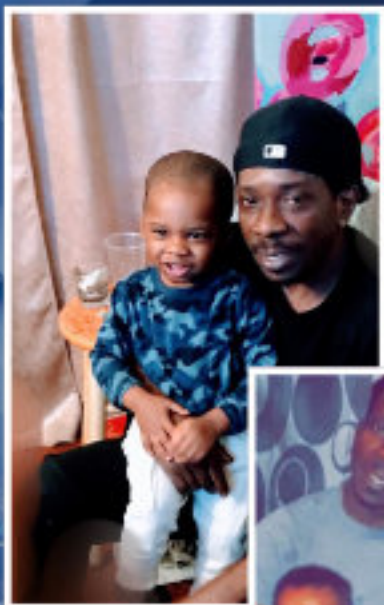
And when I think that God, his Son not sparing,
