Ramon Luis Quinones, Sr. was born on February 28, 1946 in Penuelas, Puerto Rico, to Margarita Santiago Quinones and Agustin Quinones. Ramon came to Elizabeth, New Jersey in 1952 at the age of 6. He graduated from Elizabeth High School in 1968.

After graduating from high school, Ramon was drafted and served in the United States Army as a Radio Wave Communications Specialist in Vietnam.

He was honorably discharged in 1972.

Ramon worked at Supermarkets General Corporation known as Pathmark for 32 years. He retired in 2004 at the age of 55. While at Pathmark, he enjoyed playing on the S.G.C. bowling team for many years.

After retirement, Ramon played in the Linden Lanes and Jersey Lanes bowling leagues and became a Master Craftsman. He would design and produce furniture. He created many items that pleased all of his customers.

On May 27, 1994, Ramon was joined in holy matrimony to Elalena “Julie” Andrews. They moved to Sun City West, Arizona in 2016. They renewed their vows on their 25th anniversary at a beach in California.

Ramon converted from the Catholic to the Pentecostal faith later in life and was baptized at New Hope Family Church PCG in Phoenix, Arizona in 2017.
