Deborah Ann Robinson was born on November 21, 1954 in Bronx Hospital, Bronx, N.Y. to Urban and Edna Figueira. Urban was a Corporal in the United States Marines for two years. After serving his country Urban worked at General Motors Corporation for 37 years. Edna worked as a sales clerk for a number of years, but her pride was being a homemaker for her family.

Deborah was baptized at St. Augustine's Church, the same church her parents were married at. At three and a half years of age Deb became a big sister to Victoria and then at the age of nine she welcomed her youngest sister Valerie. The family enjoyed many Saturdays at Jones Beach and the drive in movies during the summer months and spent many weekends in the winter sleigh riding.
