# **OBITUARY**

**Carl Cuthbert Roosevelt Lodge** was born on May 27, 1945, to the late Irvine Calvin Lodge and Lauretta Parnell in Brompton, St. Elizabeth. He was the eldest of four children for his mother.

Carl was raised in Brompton, St. Elizabeth for much of his childhood before moving to Pembroke Hall in Kingston, Jamaica. Carl received his formative education at Kingsway High School which allowed him to excel at Hanner's Store, his first job. A few years later, he moved on to a bigger and better position at Reginald Aitken until 1988. He never allowed obstacles to deter him, and he was continuously working hard as the owner of a stationery business.

He enjoyed raising fish, playing cricket and football, flying kites, and playing card games. He was a sports fan who enjoyed having fun with his family and friends, while maintaining a quiet but jovial demeanor. He was very friendly and easy going, nothing seemed to bother him. Carl was known by the nickname "Teach", short for teacher by his close friends and family because he was a master at playing a good card game, and that name stuck with him throughout his life.

In 1969, Carl married Florence Wood with whom he first had two children, Richard and Sophe.

In 1989, Carl immigrated to the United States of America. Years later, he met and married Patricia Gooden and this union produced one daughter, Celine. Together they both parented Celine and stepson David. He lost Patricia to breast cancer after almost a year and a half of marriage.

Carl later married his current wife, Claudette Costley in 2005 with whom he had two children, Chanté and Chantalle. Carl also raised his stepson Darren from Darren was ten years old.

Carl committed his life to Jesus Christ when he got baptized in June 2008 and he attended church regularly.

We shall tread the streets of gold. [Refrain]


