

Carl Edward Johnson was born in Cairo, Georgia (the hometown of Jackie Robinson) on December 17th, 1951. He was the son of York Daniels and Bertha Johnson. He attended Washington Consolidated High School and graduated in 1969, one year before the Grady County School System was completely integrated.

Carl thought that education was the key to a successful life. In pursuit of a higher education, he moved to New York and earned a BA degree in Communications with a specialization in Creative Writing from CCNY (The City College of New York). During his college years, his extracurricular efforts and academic achievements earned him recognition in the 1976 – 1977 publication of "Who's Who among Students in American Colleges and Universities." Having worked his way through school teaching driving lessons, he soon decided to use his communication skills to start his own business: "The Carlinda Driving School". During the start-up years of Carlinda Driving School, he worked as an inspector for the NYC Department of Consumer Affairs.


