Obituary

Sexton, Jr. (Boobie) and Craig Anthony Sexton (Amp). James drove a cab for several years until he purchased his own tire shop just blocks away from Frank's Corner Tire Shop on Blake Aveune (J&S Tireshop).

Furthering his entrepreneurial goals, he went on to purchasing a Medailian Taxi where many of the family worked for him (Horace Brathwaite, Carl Sexton, and Craig Anthony Sexton.)

On May 11, 2022, after many battles with several debilitating ailments, James was called home by the Lord. 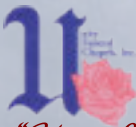
Psalm 23
