He had his 1st degree at University of DC in Washington and proceeded to Morgan State University in Baltimore, Maryland while delivering newspaper as a side hustle with a degree in town planning Regional development.

He went back to Nigeria and established Clearing & Forwarding company which he ran for five years. He came back to the US after the Abacha regime closed down the port. After his arrival in the US he moved to NJ where he did so many jobs like driving cabs and some other stuff to keep body and soul together. He went back to school to study computer science in which he excelled in and taught in school until his demise. He eventually got a job with the Irvington Board of Education as teacher until death on May 25th 2022.

Olatunde was a man who lived his life with pride, dignity and humor. He was a committed family man who believed in hard work and sacrifices. He was a people person who affected different people in different ways. He was a truthful and fair person who will say it the way it is. Olatunde has always been a person after the heart of God, right from the time he was a kid when they will carry the bible on their head following their father to church. Their father was a devoted christian of The Apostolic Faith Church which he believed in until attended some years ago when he joined the Four Square Gospel Church in Elizabeth, NJ. It was obvious that he loved God and he worked in so many capacities serving God. He further went on to earn his doctorate degree in Theology and had since served God in this capacity.

Thine is a perfect rest, secure and deepGood-night! Good-night! Good-night!


Until the shadows from this earth are cast, Until He gathers in His sheaves at last, Until the twilight gloom be over past-Good-night! Good-night!


Until the Easter glory lights the skies, Until the dead in Jesus shall arise, And He shall come, but not in lowly guise-Good-night! Good-night!
