## Obituary

**Robert Ciefield Jones** was born July 21, 1933, to the late Joseph H. Jones and Adelaide Jones. He departed this earthly life on Saturday, June 11, 2022 "Kippy" as he was affectionately called was born in Orange, NJ, and educated in the Orange School system. At an early age, he joined the fellowship of Ebenezer Baptist Church.

"Kippy" was an active Member of the American Legion and serviced as a Commander in Chief in 2003. As well as a member of the Masonic Lodge. He was also a devoted supported of St. Jude's Children's Research Hospital.

"Kippy" was married to Patricia Holly in 1956. In 1961 he wed Marion Pope. On May 10, 1975 he joined Iola Jones in holy matrimony.

"Kippy" is preceded in death by his parents and siblings, Adelaide Joanne Cook and LeRoy Joseph Jones Sr. and special friend Marion "Tina "Jordan.


