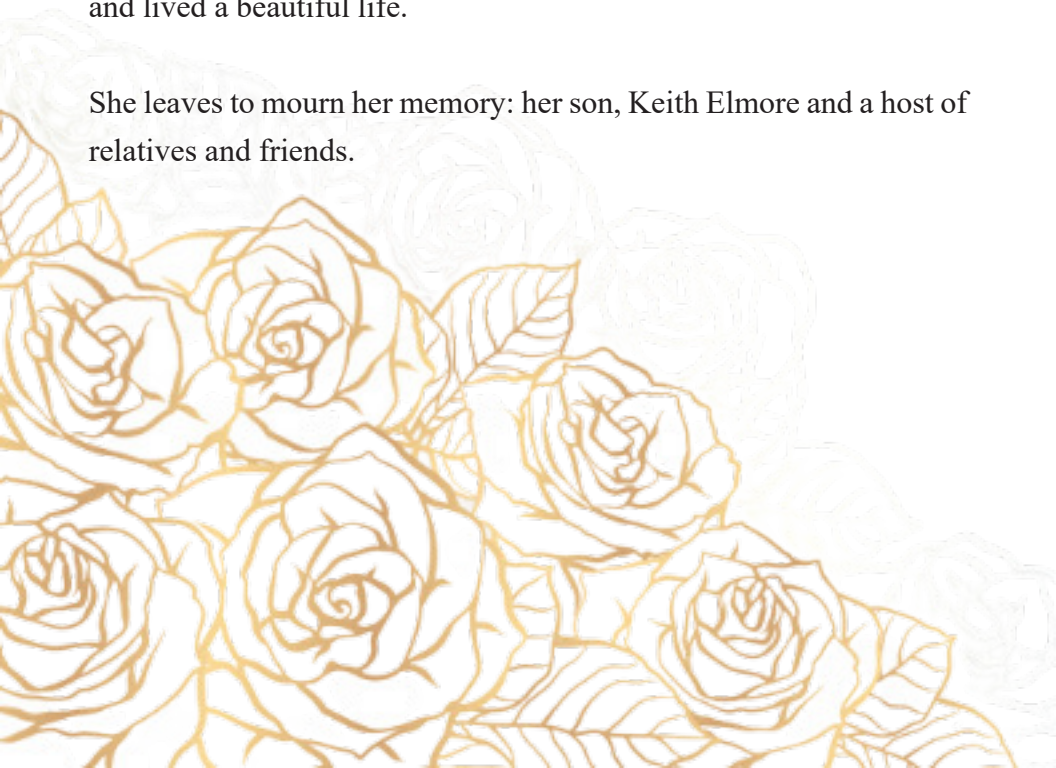
Obituary

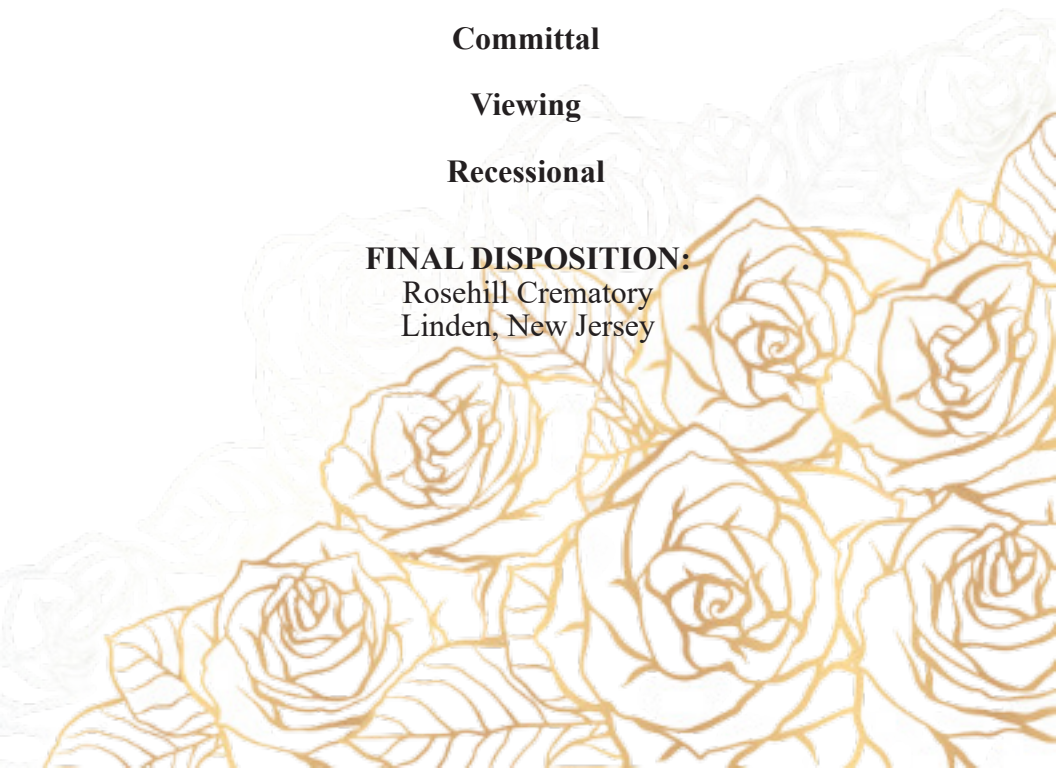
