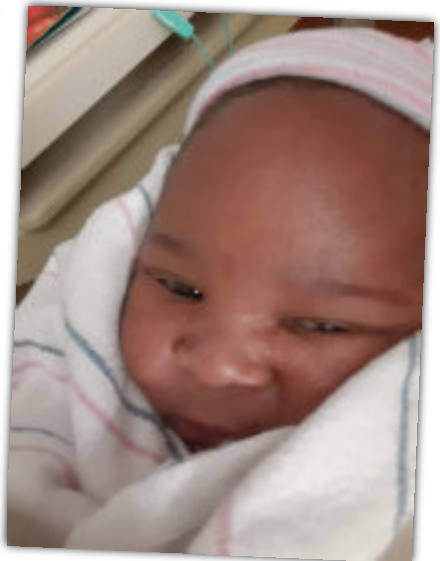
# Life Reflections

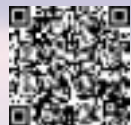
