Her favorite saying was "God willing", meaning her faith was in him. She would always have gospel music on repeat while relaxing in the comforts of her home. Elizabeth always promoted family and how checking for one another was important. She later became known as "Queen Elizabeth" by her children.

She has joined her late husband, her parents, her two sisters, Cookie and Lilly Robinson and her granddaughter, Maisha "Sabine" Bragg.
