He attended Glendevon Primary and Junior High School and later transferred to Albion Primary School between 1996-2002.

He passed his Grade Six Achievement Test (GSAT) Exam to progress to Anchovy High School between the years 2002 – 2007. During this time, he was elected to numerous leadership positions such as Class Monitor, Prefect, Deputy Head Boy and Head Boy.

Dwayne was very active at that institution, being a member of the Science Quiz Club, School Challenge Quiz Club and the Inter-School Christian Fellowship (ISCF). He won various awards and trophies.
