## OBITUARY

Pastor Clive Michael "Billy" Boothe, age 48 of Goshen, NY is the son of the late Elfreda Williamson and Byron Kirk Boothe. He was born in Kingston Jamaica on October 14, 1974. Billy received his education through the education system of Jamaica and was a graduate of St. Elizabeth Technical High School in 1992.

Billy is survived by six brothers: Andrew Boothe, Barrington Boothe, Steven Boothe, Phillip Boothe, Tyrell Boothe, and Tyson Boothe, a sister Shakarra Boothe, a host of cousins, aunts, uncles, friends, and a devoted church community.

Billy at an early age professed his faith in God and attended the church of his late grandmother, Mother Johanna D. Boothe who nurtured his understanding of the word of God. Billy received his Associates Degree in Theology from Jerusalem, A Church Without Walls Ministry Training School in 2015. After completing this course, he became an instructor teaching the Theology class for three years. In 2019, Billy enrolled at Christ Theological Seminary to further his studies but was unable to complete this program due to the pandemic. In 2015, Billy was ordained as a Pastor and at the time of his passing, was continuing his studies in the ministry at SUM Bible College and Theological Seminary. Additionally, he was employed as an independent contractor and was on his way to work at the time of his tragic death on November 10, 2022.

On April 21, 2012, Billy married Marie, a hairstylist and they became proud parents of two children from this union, David Boothe and Dominique Boothe. Billy was also the proud father to Jessica Boothe and Yanique McKenzie.

Billy was a man of God, a devoted husband and father, brother, and friend to many. An individual made the following statement: "The measure of a life is not in its duration but in its donation." When we think of Billy's donation, what he contributed to the work of the Lord, what he invested, we have much to be thankful for.

- consider the investment of love and devotion in his marriage with Marie.
- consider the investment of godliness and nurturing that Billy made into the lives of his children.
- consider the investment in the Word of God that Billy made into the lives of so many people.

When I think of Billy, I think of the verse in Revelation 14:13 that says:
