**Kim Murray** was born on June 29, 1964, in New York City. She left us on Friday, January 6, 2023.

Kim loved to travel, dance, entertain and cook. She had the opportunity to vacation in Jamaica, the Bahamas, Puerto Rico, Cancun, and Myrtle Beach. She also enjoyed traveling to California and South Carolina to spend time with family.

Kim inherited her culinary skills from her mother, who was an excellent cook. Kim's cousins often teased her about being a good cook, but not quite as good as Aunt Carrie. But then, neither were any of us! Kim would prepare meals and deliver them to her uncles when they got up in age. She blessed many of us with her cooking skills.

Kim also had a greeting card ministry. Family and friends could count on receiving birthday cards, mother's day cards, father's day cards, Christmas cards, Easter cards – you name it. She was so faithful and made us all want to do better in that area.

Kim was a lifelong resident of New York. She grew up in the Bronx, and later moved to Yonkers, but had her sights set on returning to the Riverdale section of the Bronx. Kim attended Touro College in the mid-eighties and The College of New Rochelle from 2002 – 2003.

Kim worked for the New York City Police Department for over 10 years as an Administrative Aide. She went on to work as a New York City Corrections Officer, where she remained until her retirement.

Preceding her in death are her parents, Hammond Murray and Carrie Bell Phinzy, as well as her brother, Kelvin Murray. Kim leaves her son, Kashiem Murray, nephews Jermaine Heard and Jason Murray, and a host of family and devoted friends.

Him in my soul

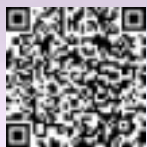
