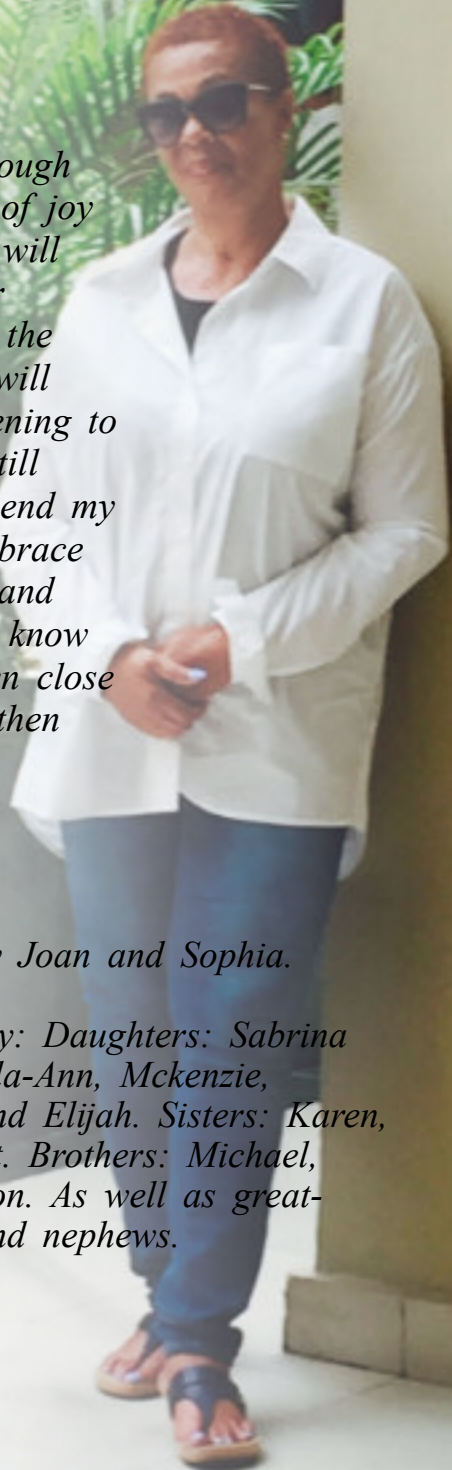
# *A Mother's Love*
