



<u>Obituary</u>

Odell Albert, Sr. was born on March 25, 1930 in Sumter, South Carolina, son of Hattie Mae Albert and David Washington Gass.

Raised in Sumter, South Carolina, Odell, affectionately known as "Dell" and "Yogi", was educated in the Sumter County School System.

Odell met and married Dorothy Mae McDuffie and they were blessed with 62 years of marriage.

Odell entered the United States Armed Services, Division of the Army in 1952 at the age of 22 and served in the Korean War. Odell served active duty from 1952 to 1955 after which he served in the Army Reserves until he was Honorably Discharged in 1961.

Odell was a founding member of the Antioch A.M.E. Church where he served as a Trustee and Treasurer.

Odell began his career as a truck driver for Formula Floor Products for several years, prior to being promoted to Sales Manager. His territory covered the entire East Coast. He was also a founding member of the Linden 5 Corporation, one of the few minority corporations that was instrumental in minority ownership of corporate properties in the townships of Linden and Roselle, New Jersey. He was last employed at Raceway Industries where he held the position of transportation and shipping manager retiring in 1996.

Odell Albert, Sr. departed this life peacefully on Friday, January 6, 2023. He was predeceased by his wife, Dorothy Mae Albert, his parents, 1 brother and 1 sister.

Odell leaves to cherish fond memories, two sons, Odell, Jr. (Debra), Edward (Lazara), one daughter, Sharon Albert, 4 grandchildren, 6 great-grandchildren, a niece, Flossie Mae Cook and a sister-in-law, Alphenia Montgomery, both of Sumter, South Carolina. Extended family nephews, Ronald Terry and Fred Jones and nieces Francis Jones and Fatima Terry. He also leaves his cousin and lifelong friend, Sonny Pershay (Mary).
