## *Obituary*

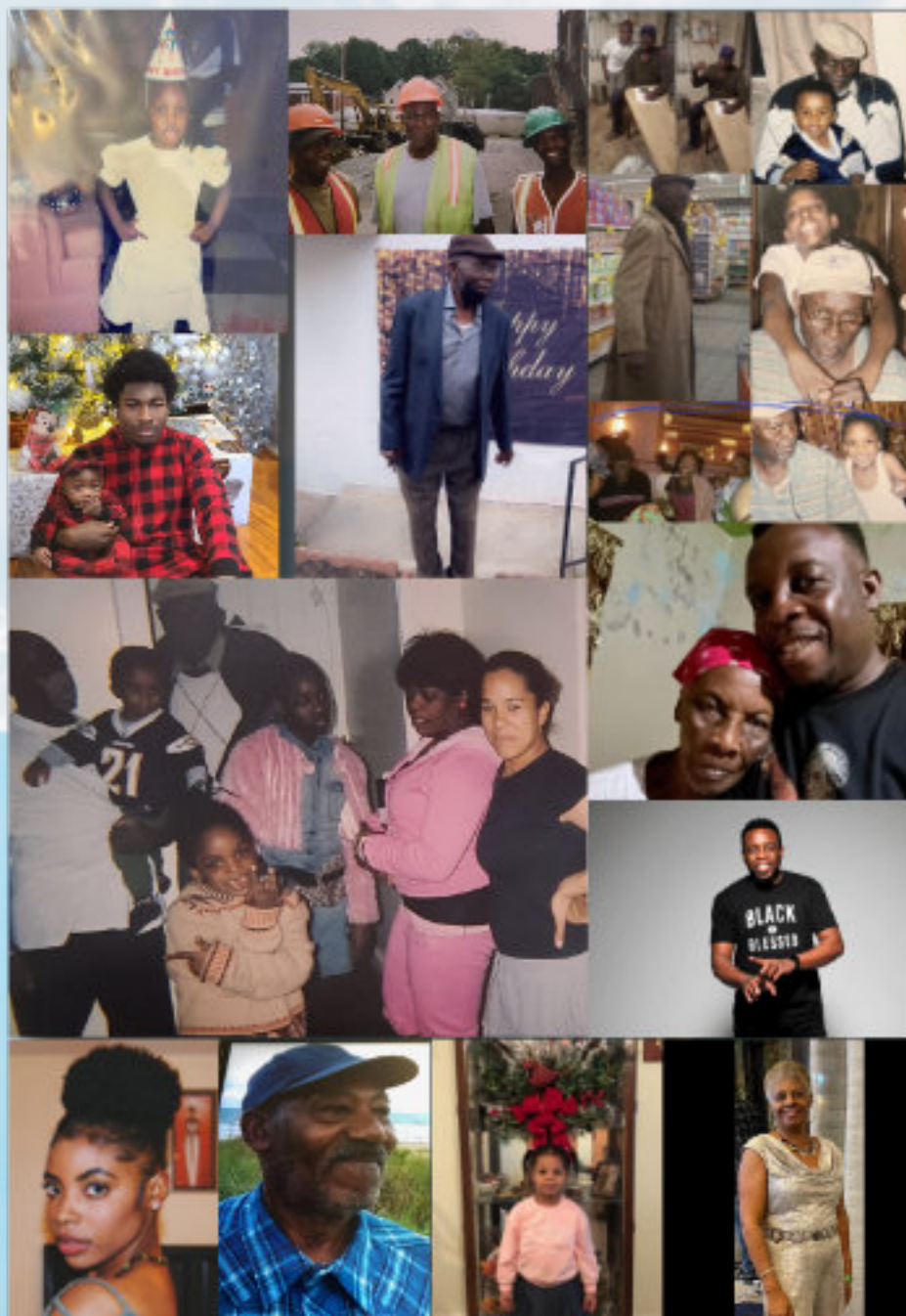

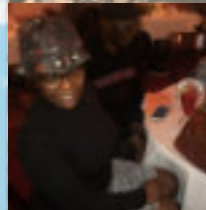
