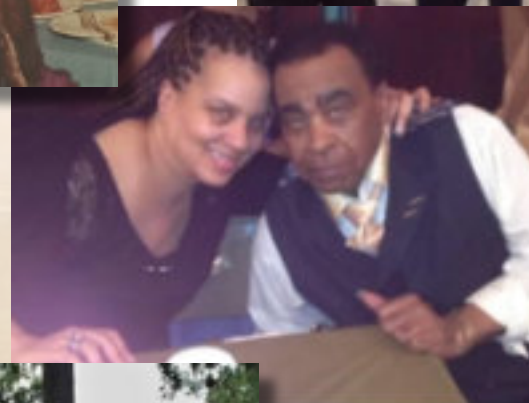
Life is but a Stopping Place
