Obituary

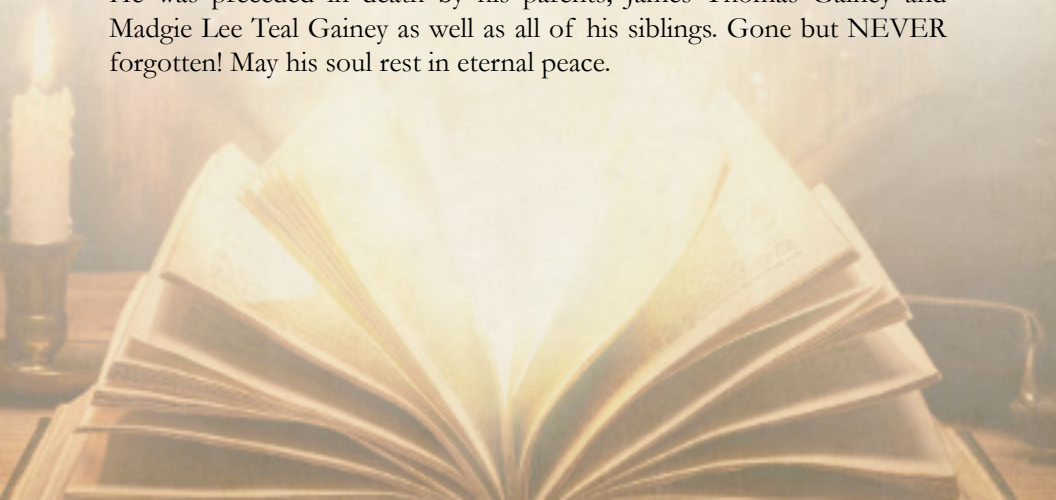
