And if you listen with your heart you'll hear

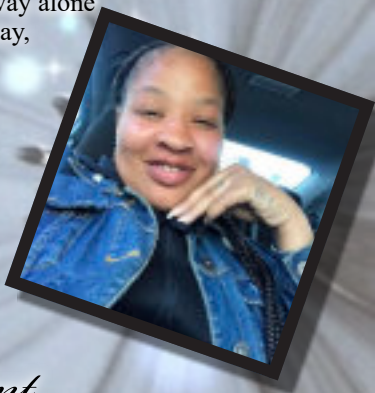
All my love around you so soft and clear
