Miguel R. Santos, 63, of East Greenbush, passed away Wednesday, November 16th 2022, at his home.

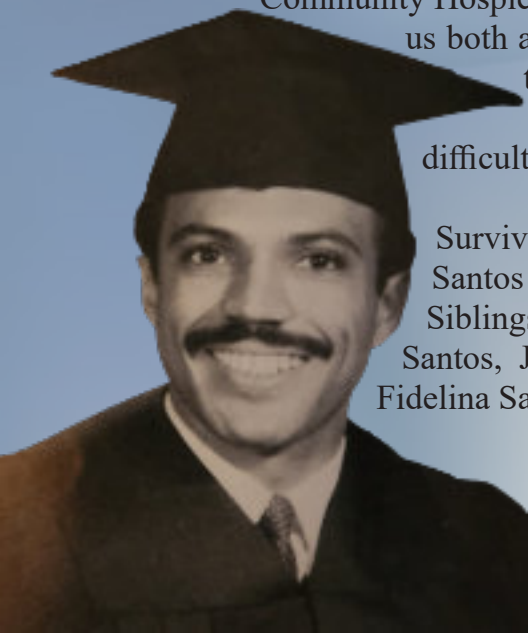
Miguel was born May 20, 1959, in Villa Gonzales, the son of the late Jorge Santos and Carmen (Tavares) Santos.
