Obituary

Inez Thora Calvin (Jordan) born on March 13th, 1930. She was born to Mary and Clinton Calvin in the Hanover parish of the island of Jamaica, West Indies. Inez attended Green Island School and was the 5th out of 12 children. She had ten sisters and one brother. At 20 years of age, she traveled to Montego Bay in Jamaica to start her career as a hairdresser.

Inez loved her family, worked diligently, and sought to help her sisters accomplish their dreams of a better life in America. In 1952, she migrated here to the United States with her aunt Eva McKensie. Inez returned to Jamaica in 1954. After her father Clinton passed in 1955, she had her daughter Maxine in 1957. Inez returned to the US where she would settle in 1960 and got married in 1963. She had her son, Andrew Jordan in 1965.

Inez lived in Harlem and worked in Bloomingdales, selling cosmetics. She would travel home to Jamaica twice a year to visit her family. Inez would bring barrels of food, clothes, and other items to her family when she visited. Her mother Mary preceded her in death in 1972.

Inez relocated to a two-family home in Rosedale Queens, along with her sister. She lost her son Andrew to gun violence in 1986. She entered a nursing program and became a private duty nurse until she relocated to Ocala Florida in 1989. Inez frequently traveled back and forth to New York to visit family.

Inez was a devout Christian and was a member of Marion Oaks Assembly of God for over 30 years. She attended weekly services, including Bible study and Sunday morning worship services. Inez was affectionately known as “Grandma” and “Aunt T”. She was the matriarch of the family and loved to sing and quote scriptures, even during her health challenges. Inez was known to encourage everyone with her infectious songs of praise and uplifting worship to the Lord.

Inez was the last of her siblings and the longest living relative. She is preceded in death by her son Andrew, along with all her siblings and her parents. Inez leaves to mourn her daughter Maxine Roach, her grandsons Richard Roach Jr and Paul Roach Sr., their wives Cherisse Roach and Dayna Roach, and great-grandchildren Avree, Sydney, Paul Jr, Charlotte, Justice and Zariah, her nieces, nephews, relatives, friends, and church family.
