## Obituary

Henry Donnell Spencer, the fourth child of seven was born on January 13, 1951 to Alice Spencer and Henry Reid in Grandville County, NC. Upon his mother's sudden death on July 5, 1957, Donnell continued to receive childhood loving care from William Spencer, his uncle, Lizzie Spencer, his aunt, in addition to his grandparents, Cleveland Spencer, Sr. and Laura Spencer. Donnell left Spring Grove Rehabilitation & Healthcare Center, New Providence, NJ at the age of 72 peacefully in his sleep on Sunday morning December 31, 2023, to be with the Lord and his eternal family. Donnell was educated in the Morris School District and graduated from Morristown High School in June 1969. Upon graduation, Donnell entered the US ARMY on September 30, 1969. He served in Germany during the Vietnam War and was honorable discharged, September 29, 1975. Upon returning to Morristown, NJ, Donnell's love for cooking while in the service led him as head chef at the Hvatt Regency Hotel in Morristown and soon after he started catering for lawyers, schools, weddings and more. This enticed Donnell to open his catering business under "SPENCER FOR HIRE" Construction and Catering Company, where he also loved renovating and flipping houses. He was licensed in electrical and plumbing in NJ, PA, and CT. Donnell also volunteered a great deal of time helping build homes with Habitat for Humanity. Donnell was superintendent for several different residential buildings in the Montclair area. The Montclair YMCA employed Donnell as their building maintenance and residential supervisor for decades. After his untimely motorcycle accident in August 2011, and suffering from lifelong injuries, he retired, keeping his communication ongoing with his co-workers who has become lifetime friends. After retirement, Donnell also served as a crossing guard for the Montclair district. Donnell was predeceased by his parents Alice Spencer and Henry Reid, his sister, Mary G. Jackson (1979), his brothers, Edmund M. Johnson (2019), Robert C. Banks (2004), and his grandson, Dejan D. Foster (2019). Donnell will be lovingly remembered by his son Preston, Newark, NJ, and 2 daughters Jo-Anna, Hillside, NJ, Jalena, Jamestown, NC, four grandchildren, Tania, Shanae, Elijah, Meikel, two brothers, William E. Spenser (Shelia) Puyallup, WA, Herbert W. Banks (Jessi) So. Plainfield, NJ, two sisters, Pamela Banks Depew, Roxboro, NC, Gwendolyn Aiken (Edward) Stanhope NJ, sister in law Veron Johnson, a special nephew, Deacon Charles E. Johnson (Diane) and a host of nephews, nieces, cousins, family and friends.
