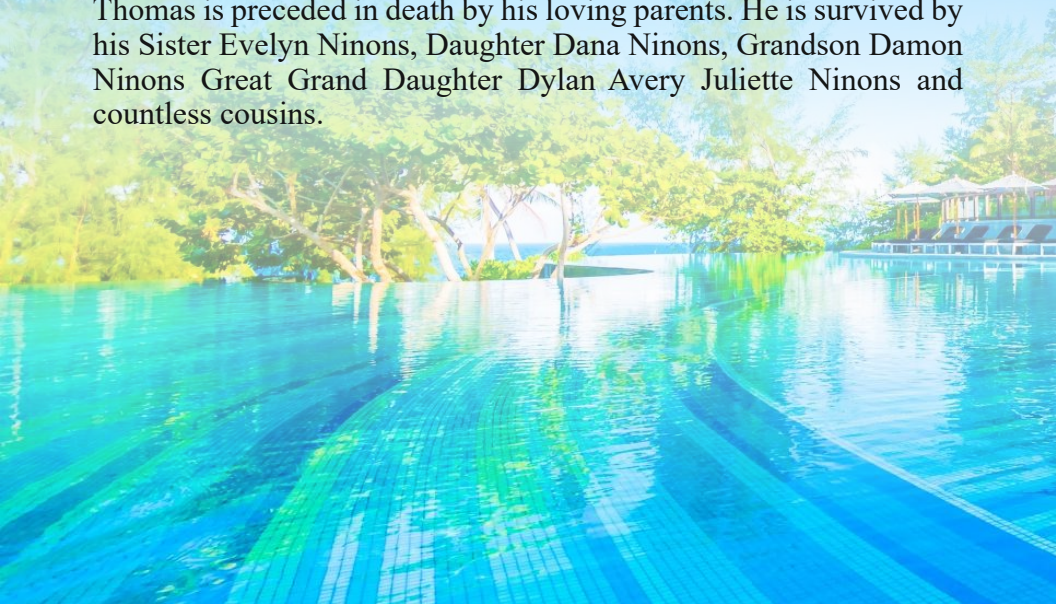
Thomas C. Ninons was born in Harlem, NY to proud parents Hize & Mildred Ninons on January 26, 1941.

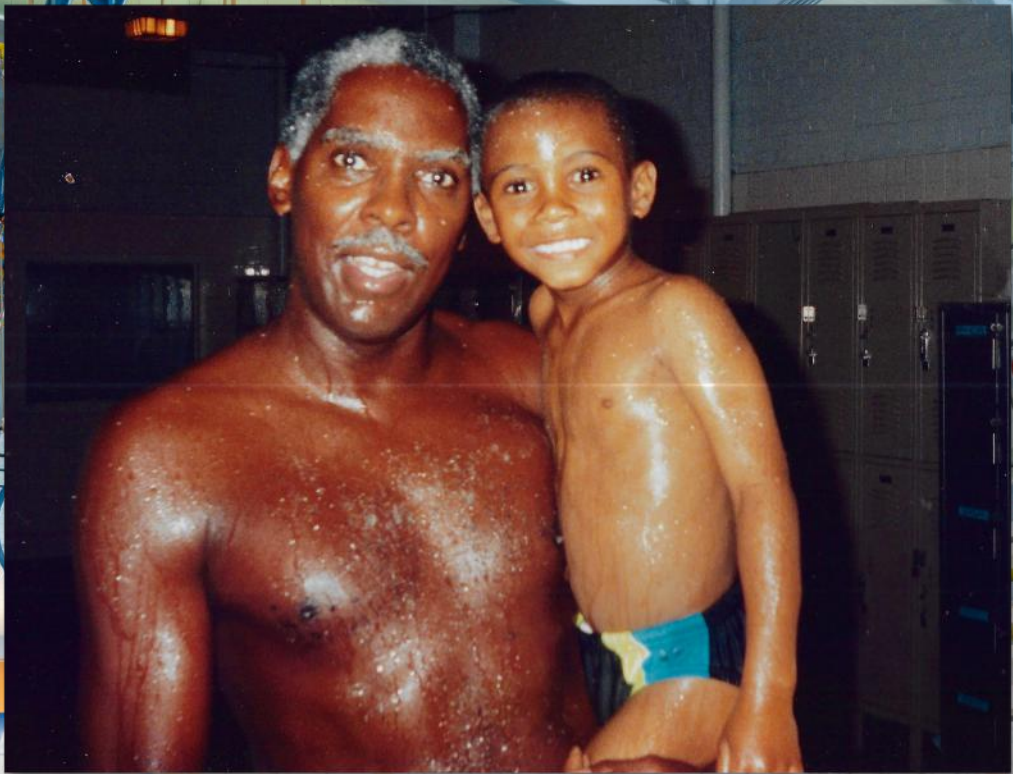

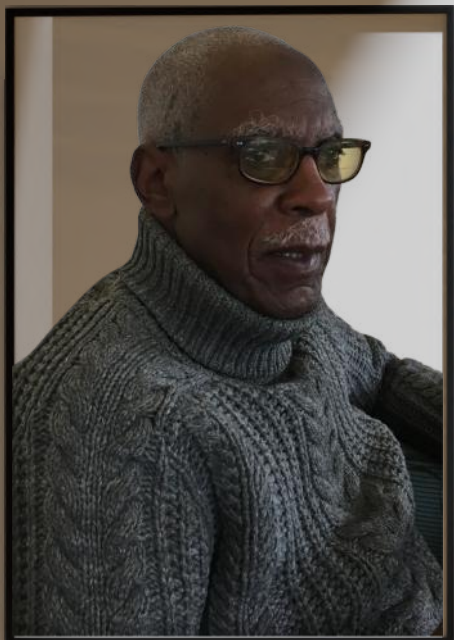
