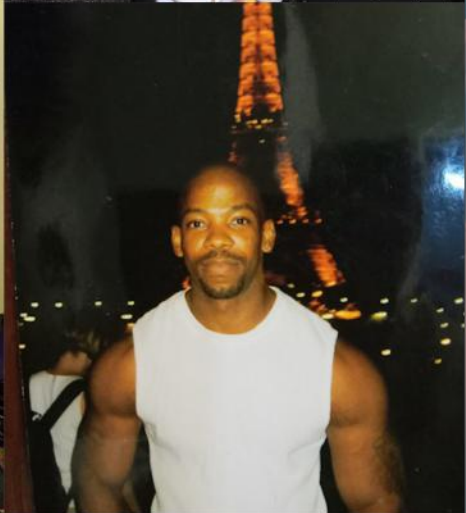
Andre met Michelle “Diane” Douglass and they were blessed with baby girl, Amber Douglass in November of 1989. Amber was the love of his life.
