OBITUARY

Derrick Hopeton Burford of Queens, NY, passed away unexpectedly at his home on March 21, 2024, with his beloved wife Beverly by his side. His health declined suddenly after battling COPD, a respiratory illness. Derrick was only 65 years of age.

Derrick was born on September 3, 1958, to Dudley and Winifred Burford in St. Mary, Jamaica, he migrated to the United States in 1975. He attended New Rochelle High School and Apex Technical School. In July 1977, Derrick joined the United States Marines and was stationed at Camp Lejeune in North Carolina.

While in North Carolina, he met Mary Herring and she bore him their first son, Derrick Jr. in 1979. They moved to New Rochelle, NY where he spent most of his life. In 1995, Derrick met Janet Kirlew. They had his second son, Jonathan in 1997. In 2006 he met and married Beverly Mattie. She had a daughter, Khadijah whom he cared for and took as his very own, from the moment they met. He became a grandfather to Mahkai Steadman in 2020.

Derrick worked for the New Rochelle School District for 28 years. He was set to retire on June 21, 2024, 3 months to the date of his passing. His work ethics are to be admired. Derrick rarely missed work. Only hospitalization or extreme emergencies would keep him away.

Derrick was a very private and discreet person. He was very generous, intelligent, caring, courageous, daring, strict, and very organized. He enjoyed fishing, reading, especially the newspaper every morning, cooking, and watching wrestling. He loved and adored his mother. He looked forward to retiring so he could spend more time in Florida with her. He was also looking forward to traveling to the Dominican Republic with his son Jonathan. His passing has come as a great shock and deep wound. It is gravely felt by his entire family, co- workers, and countless others who loved him deeply.

Derrick is survived by his mother Winifred, wife Beverly, sons Derrick Jr. and Jonathan, daughter Khadijah, grandson Mahkai, sisters Auldine, Barbara, Claudette, Janet, Paulette, and Purle, brother Clement as well as many Nieces, Nephews and Cousins.
